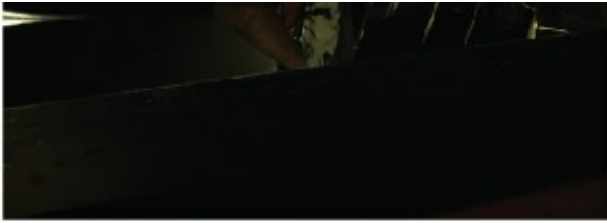


WGN radio and TV Personalities host a Successful FUNdraiser at Zanies Comedy Club for ClaySpace Ceramic Arts Center
