Join us in the ClaySpace Gallery for the opening of "A Feast of Bowls" by Resident Artist Nancy Jana Kent on Friday, February 5 from 7 - 9 pm.

Nancy shares, "I love making bowls, so I decided to focus on this form. I've spent months working on new colors, shapes and techniques; and I'm very happy with the results. I'll be showing: Berry, Decorative, Double and Triple, Fruit, Nesting, Mixing, Pasta, Serving - Huge, Large, Medium, and Small, Soup, Salad, Cereal and Ice Cream and Yarn Bowls.

Why only bowls? Bowls are a simple, ancient, form, used and overlooked most days, but where I find inspiration. For

example, creating a green decorative edge on a serving bowl makes mashed potatoes look even more yummy; Or adding handles on a soup bowl moves hot food safely and adds style and interest. It makes me happy when you can start your day with breakfast in a bowl that is your favorite color, or end the day with ice cream in a beautiful bowl. I have made a room full of bowls for you to find the perfect one for you. Hoping to add a special touch of art to life, please come and find a bit of beauty for your day."


